Begin the holiday season with an Origami Ornament! With five or six square pieces of paper, three very simple folds, and a little bit of glue you will have a beautiful ornament for many different occasions. Learn the basics. Explore the possibilities! Demo provided by Maria Rebelo.

Materials

1 - Paper

One ornament will take 5-6 pieces of squared paper.

The size is entirely up to you. I like to use the pre-cut origami paper 5" x5"; It is a good size to learn the fold.

Besides origami paper, we can use any paper that folds well.

Toyo Tant Origami paper is a bit heavier than regular origami but folds beautifully and comes in a wide array of colors.

The paper can be double sided or not

2 - Bone folder, if you have one

3 - A Glue stick; it works better than wet glue [like PVA]

4 - A piece of ribbon, thread, yarn, about 8" long. This will be used to make the little loop to hang the ornament

5 - Beads or buttons to decorate the loop
