Two-Sewn-as-One Mini Books

First we will make a small model of the structure.

Then you can choose any size paper and cover for your individual project.

Materials & Supplies:

Pencil

Eraser

Ruler

Scissors or craft knife & mat

Bone folder (or palette knife or butter knife)

Linen book binding thread, waxed or unwaxed (or perle cotton or embroidery floss or upholstery thread or quilting thread or very thin ribbon or string or dental floss)

Blunt embroidery needle (with eye to accommodate your sewing material)

Awl (or push pin or sharp stylus)

4-6 bulldog clips or large paper clips

Glue (or glue stick or double-sided tape)

For the model:

About 10 sheets of copy or text weight paper (8 1/2 " x 11 " or 9" x 12")

A piece of card stock about 6" x 12"

For your individual finished book:

Assorted paper, any type (will be folded) - can be different heights and lengths! Card stock or thicker paper for the cover (height of the tallest paper in you book block and about 3 times the width)

Optional: Closure (Button or large brad)
